Sub: Utilization of PG Pass-outs of ESIC Institutions (ESIC-SRs) - Revision in posting guidelines - Clarification regarding - reg.

The undersigned is directed to refer to clarifications sought in r/o Memorandum dated 06/102020. The clarifications / replies are as under:

	Queries asked / Suggestions given	Clarification
a.	Whether the posting of PG pass out as ESIC-SR in the parent institution would automatically come into effect from the day following completion of their PG tenure or an order will be issued to this effect?	♦ An order will need to be issued
b.	If an order is to be issued to the PG pass outs will it be issued by the respective Dean/Medical Superintendent or by Head Quarters? (as appointing authority for SRs in this institute is the Medical Superintendent).	 The order would be issued to the ESIC-SRs by the Authority competent to appoint SRs (under Central Residency Scheme), /i.e. MS or Dean as the case may be.
C.	Will this memo come into effect retrospectively for the Batch 2017-20 who passed out in June, 2020 to August 2020 or prospectively from Batch 2018-2021 onwards?	 Memo will be applicable to all batches currently waiting for their posting and for future batches
d.	If order is applicable to Batch 2017-2020, when will the bond period of ESIC-SR begin for their 2 year ESIC-Residency as the batch 2017-2020 have already completed their PG Residency tenure during period of June-August, 2020.	 The Bond period would begin from the date of their joining.
e.	Will the working strength of ESIC-SR in the parent institution be over & above the regular sanctioned strength of regular SR's of three year residency presently working in the respective institutions?	 Yes, as per approval (reporting) of the Corporation at its 168th imeeting However, the number of SR's under Central Residency \$cheme may be appropriately reduced as per the local need, considering that ESIC-SR will be available for 9 months at the institution. A committee may be constituted at local level for same .

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f.	The utilization of service of ESIC-SR in other state ESI institutions for a period of one month at a time & 3 times in a year as mentioned in memorandum point 2 is apparently too brief to be of any usefulness to those hospitals. It will help if the tenure is at least for 3 months at a stretch for 2 such block period during the 2 year bond period.	 Para (2.1) of Memorandum dated 06/10/2020 would now read as under: Routinely, the diversion would not be for a period exceeding three months at a time; and such diversions would not routinely exceed once a year. It may be ensured that period of diversion is effectively for three months. During diversion, no more than 03 leave would be allowed per month. In case, the leave availed is more, it may be verified if the leave request is genuine.
g.	Whether the postings for the ESIC)SR services as per point 2.1 & 3 will be carried out by Head Quarter's or will be by respective Dean/Medical Superintendent?	 The Dean Office would call for requirements from ESIC hospitals attached to their institution. A roster for diversion would be prepared in a manner that services of ESIC-SRs are available for the maximum possible time to the other institutions. Action in this regard may be completed by Deans by 31/10/2020. A report in this regard will be sent on monthly basis to Medical Administration, HQ. The Deans of Institutions should complete action in r/o above by 31.10.2020
