2. Generic

Bidder financial standing: The bidder should not be under liquidation, court receivership or similar proceedings, should not be bankrupt. Bidder to upload undertaking to this effect with bid.

3. Generic

1. The Seller shall not assign the Contract in whole or part without obtaining the prior written consent of buyer.

2. The Seller shall not sub-contract the Contract in whole or part to any entity without obtaining the prior written consent of buyer.

3. The Seller shall, notwithstanding the consent and assignment/sub-contract, remain jointly and severally liable and responsible to buyer together with the assignee/ sub-contractor, for and in respect of the due performance of the Contract and the Sellers obligations there under.

ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF TENDERS

Bid Terms and Conditions.

Period of Contract: -The Contract shall initially be for a period of Two Years. The rates quoted by the bidder shall remain be unchanged during the period of contr act. ESIC, however, reserves the right to terminate the contract at any time without assigning any reason thereof by serving one-month notice.

Estimated value of Contract: As per GeM.

Last date of submission: Last Date of uploading of Bid is stipulated on GEM Port al.

Date of opening of Bids: Technical bid will be opened on stipulated date and tim e on GEM Portal.

Eligibility Criteria_:

- (I) The bidder should have completed the following work in the last 2year s:
- (II) One similar work not less than 05 Lakhs in a govt. agency or Organizati on.
- (III) Two Years of Experience required in related field.
- (IV) The bidder must be registered with all labour laws e.g. ESIC, EPFO, Minimum Payment of Wages etc., if applicable and all taxation law e.g. GST etc.
- (V) The bidder must have a PAN number.

Evaluation of technical and financial bid.

- a. The Bidders are required to upload Technical bid as per Bid Specification uploaded on GEM Portal.
- b. Each and every page of attached document should be signed and stampe d by the bidder or its authorized representative.
- c. The competent authority of ESIC Hospital, Kolhapur reserves the right to reject all or any Bid in whole, or in part, without assigning any reason ther eof.
- d. Incomplete or conditional bid in any form will be rejected.
- e. contract shall be executed into with the successful Bidder. In this contract , the successful Bidder shall be defined as Contractor.

Performance Security Deposit: The successful Bidder will have to deposit th e Performance Security Deposit of 3 % of Bid Value and execute the contract wit hin one month from the date of award of contract. No interest will be paid for P BG.

General Terms and Conditions:-

- a. The tenderer will be responsible for supply of all such items/ equipment's used in Catering Services.
- b. Employment of child labour is at all not permissible and will lead to termi nation of the contract.
- c. The Contractor at all times should indemnify ESIC against all claims, dam ages or compensation under the provisions of Payment of Wages Act, 1936; Minimum Wages Act, 1948; Employer's Liability, Act, 1938; the Workmen Compensation Act, 1923; Industrial Disputes Act, 1 947; Maternity Benefit Act, 1961, ESI Act, 1947; EPFO Act, 1952 o r any modification thereof or any other law relating thereto and rules ma de hereunder from time to time. ESIC will not own any responsibility in thi s regard.
- d. In case of breach of any terms and, conditions attached to the contract, t he Performance Security Deposit of the Contractor will be liable to be forf eited by ESIC besides annulment of the contract.
- e. The Contractor shall pay Wages as per **Minimum** wages act, EPF, ESI contribution (if applicable) contribution to the employees engaged by them at ESIC premises. Contractor shall employ adult and trained labour only.
- f. The Contractor shall ensure timely payment of all statutory dues like ESI, EPF (if applicable), GST and other tax etc. and ensure compliance of pay ment of Wages Act, Minimum Wages Act etc.
- g. The Contractor shall engage only such workers, whose antecedents have been thoroughly verified, including character and police verification and other formalities. The Contractor must also ensure that they are of decen t character, sound physical & mental health and possess general abilities to carry out the required works and are also able to read instructi ons.
- h. The Contractor shall keep the Complaint Book with them to record compl aints and this book shall be open for inspection by the persons duly autho rized by the Medical Superintendent. The Contractor should make reason able efforts to resolve the complaints recorded in the complaint register t o the satisfaction of this organization.
- i. The contractor should submit the bill after the month's end.
- j. The contractor should use AGMARK/FPO/FSSAI or such standard quality of food articles approved by relevant regulatory authorities. Certificate in thi s regard should be displayed prominently in the premises.
- k. The Contractor shall provide photo-identity cards and uniforms to the wor kers and it should be ensured that all the workers bear proper uniform an d displays identity card throughout the working hours. The uniform shall be as approved by ESIC, also Hand gloves, Mask & Caps has to be provide d by contractor themselves.

- Any misconduct/ misbehavior on the part of the manpower deployed by t he Contractor will not be tolerated and such person will have to be replac ed by the Contractor at his own costs, risks and responsibilities immediat ely, with written intimation to the Medical Superintendent, ESIC Hospital, Kolhapur.
- m. The instructions issued by the contractor's side, they have to follow all in structions and orders given by General Branch/Medical Superintendent.
- n. A surprise inspection for Quality and Quantity of food can be done by the by General Branch/Medical Superintendent or any authorize person.
- o. The persons deployed by the tenderer should be properly trained, have r equisite experience and skills for carrying out a wide variety of Catering S ervice work using appropriate materials and tools and equipment.
- p. The contractor shall strictly observe and adhere the following that their d eployed Catering Service personals Are always smartly turned out and vi gilant.
- (I) Take charges of their duties properly and thoroughly.
- (II) Perform their duties with honesty and sincerity.
- (III) Extend respect to all Officers and Staff of the office.
- (IV) Will immediately report to the Competent Authority of any untoward incident/ misconduct or misbehavior.
- (V) It is the sole responsibility of the deployed Catering Service personnel to execute the assigned work perfectly and neatly. If any damages are cause d to ESIC's assets while discharging the duty, suitable amount will be reco vered / deducted from the Performance Security deposit and/or from him.
- (VI) The contractor shall not employ any person of age below 18 years a nd above the age of 60 years.
- (VII) The contractor must ensure that employee suffering from any active infectious illness should abstain from duty.
- (VIII) Food poisoning, disease caused by unhygienic food would b e whole responsibility of contractor. Penalty or compensation for the same shall be borne by Contractor/Supplier.
- (IX) The Contractor should supply only freshly food items. At an y time, stale or bad food should not at all be distributed for consu mption and if found such case, legal action will be taken.
- (X) Preemployment medical screening for infectious diseases s hall be done by employer, such as chest Xray and relevant blood and other investigations required for food handlers by the own co st of employer.

q. Risk Clauses: -

- i. The tenderer shall at all times has standby arrangements for carrying o ut the work under the Contract in case of any failure of the existing arr angement.
- ii. ESIC Hospital, Kolhapur reserve the right for termination of the contract at any time by giving one month written notice, if the services are foun d unsatisfactory and also has the right to award the contract to any ot her contractor at the cost, risk and responsibilities of Contractor and e xcess expenditure incurred during the notice period on account of this will be recovered by ESIC from the Contractor's Security Deposit or by raising a separate claim.
- iii. All necessary reports and other information will be supplied on a mutua lly agreed basis and regular meetings will be held with the ESIC.
- iv. Contractor and its staff shall take proper and reasonable precautions t o prevent loss, destructions, waste or misuse the areas of responsibility given to them by the ESIC and shall not lend to any pers on or company any of the effects or assets of the ESIC under its control . In the event of loss/damage of equipment etc. at the premises of the ESIC due to negligence / carelessness of Contractor staff, then the Con tractor shall compensate the loss to ESIC.
- v. The Contractor will also maintain a suggestion book for comments on t he services rendered by it
- vi. The Contractor shall, in performing its part of this Agreement, ensure t he safety of the building **and the persons working in or visiting th e ESIC's premises and shall** indemnify ESIC for any loss or damage caused by any act of the Contractor or its employees or staff etc.
- vii. The Contractor shall not assign or sublet this Agreement or any partth ereof to any third party without the approval of the ESIC.
- r. Dispute Settlement: It is mutually agreed that all differences and dis putes arising out of or in connection with this Agreement shall be settled by mutual discussions and Negotiations, if such disputes and differences cannot be settled and resolve by discussions and negotiations then the sa me shall be referred to the Sole Arbitrator appointed by the Medical Supe rintendent, ESIC Hospital, Kolhapur whose decision shall be final and binding on both the parties. All the disputes relating to the tender shall b e subjected only to the territorial jurisdiction of Kolhapur.
- s. Termination clause: -During the period of agreement if it is found that t he agency is not providing proper services or charging by fraudulent man ner or otherwise, the security deposit (3% Value of the contract) deposite d with ESIC or part there shall be forfeited in favour of_ESIC and agreem ent will be terminated after giving one-month notice. However, if any sen suousness conduct or breach of contract terms and conditions violated or



any sexual harassment found the competent authority has sole power to halt the Catering service with immediate effect.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
